

INSTRUCTIONS FOR QUESTIONNAIRE

You must create a questionnaire using these instructions.

You may use any layout and you may decide how each question will be answered (e.g. circling, ticking, underlining, deleting, numbering, etc)

- The questionnaire must gather data about one child, including age and gender.
- The questionnaire must include these three questions:

Question 1. a. Does your child use the internet at home? <i>Possible answers are: Yes, No</i> b. If yes, in which room do they usually use it? Choose one: <i>Possible answers are: Living Room, Bedroom, Dining Room, Other (Please specify)</i>
Question 2. How often does your child use social networking sites? Choose one: <i>Possible answers are: Every day, More than once a week, Once a week, Once a month, Less than once a month, Never</i>
Question 3. In your opinion, what are your child's five favourite online activities? Please rate them from 1 to 5 where 1 is your child's favourite. <i>Choices are: Chat Rooms, Blogging, Music, Instant Messenger, Gaming, File sharing, Social Networking, Web surfing, Other (Please specify)</i>

- The questionnaire must include five other questions. Think carefully about these extra questions so that you can carry out useful analysis. For example, you might want to compare different ages or genders. The questions may be on any of these topics:
 - blogs
 - chat
 - cyber-bullying
 - digital footprints
 - file sharing
 - gaming
 - general
 - instant messaging
 - mobile phones
 - music downloads
 - phishing
 - reporting internet abuse
 - social networking
 - spam
 - viruses/spyware
 - web browsing
