Planning notes

You may use any suitable software to produce your project plan but it must show:

- a start date and finish date for the project
- all the main tasks and sub-tasks
- the order in which you will carry out the tasks make sure it is logical
- the planned start date for each main task and sub-task
- how much time is allowed for each main task and sub-task

• where you have allowed contingency time - in case you need it when things don't go according to plan

- checkpoints when you will review your progress with your teacher and agree any changes to your plan
- when test users and reviewers will look at your work

• columns for monitoring your progress - actual start dates, timings and comments
